









The Hawthorns stands in very large landscaped gardens and enjoys views at the rear onto Turn Moss playing fields.

To the front of the building is Longford Park, dating back to 1857, when Longford Hall and it's associated grounds were constructed and laid out by John Rylands, the famous cotton merchant and benefactor of many of Stretford's civic buildings. Shopping facilities are available in nearby Stretford, and Chorlton with independent shops, and at the famous Trafford Centre. Both Lancashire County Cricket Club's Old Trafford ground and the home of Manchester United are within easy reach.


